

## Vaccination Policy

As of September 7 2021, VGC will only accept fully vaccinated students for in person only classes. Students who wish to be considered for classes which are 100% face to face and on campus from September 7 onwards must be fully vaccinated. Students will need to provide proof that they have been fully vaccinated. Please note, fully vaccinated means 14 days after the second vaccination dose.

Please note:

1. Fully vaccinated means 14 days after the second vaccination dose
2. VGC has to abide by:
  - a. BC government Covid-19 prevention guidelines at the time of in person class coordination
  - b. Campus occupation restrictions as indicated by the BC government
  - c. Class sizes as indicated by the BC government
  - d. The interested student must be able to show a government issued proof of vaccination

## Future Students

- All future students must be vaccinated to attend VGC starting September 7 2021.
- Students who have had a vaccine which is non-Canadian government approved but which is approved by the WHO will be able to join in person classes once their isolation period has finished.
